The Pacific County Democrats will meet in South Bend at the County Courthouse annex on Robert Bush Dr. on **Monday Feb. 11th at 7:00 PM.**

ATTEND YOUR CAUCUS.

Saturday, February 9th at 1 PM, Democrats all over the state of Washington will gather in caucuses to elect delegates to the county and legislative district conventions. These delegates could ultimately wind up as one of the 97 delegates or 65 alternates that go to the Democratic National Convention in Denver, Colorado. Please take time to attend your caucus and exercise your right to choose delegates to the convention.

There are three locations:

- North County at Raymond Jr./ Sr. High School
- Nema, Naselle, and Bay Center at Naselle High School, and
- South County at Ilwaco High School.

You can go to the Washington State Democratic web site at www.wa-democrats.org and use the caucus finder to check on your caucus location. Just put in your name and the zip code of your legal address in and it will tell you where to caucus. Let's all turn out and participate.

SUPPORT A DEMOCRAT

On the ballots you will receive for the primary election will be a measure to approve the creation of a water utility district, and candidates for the three commissioners who will oversee operations of the district. Two members of the Pacific County Democrats are running; Marshall Tate for position #1 and Gwen Brake for position #2. If you live within the boundaries of the water district you will receive a ballot allowing you to vote for creation of the district and commissioners. Please support these qualified Democrats and vote them in as commissioners.

PRIMARY ELECTION

In addition to the caucuses, there will also be a primary election on February 19th. This will be held under the "Pick a Party" format and will include presidential picks as well as several initiatives. Ballots will be mailed January 30th and must be post marked by February 19th to be counted. Don't forget this important election.
